### Projects and duties include:

- Use Geospatial Positioning Units (GPS), digital data forms or app based forms, and hard copy data forms to collect data.
- Work with other field staff, under the supervision of field leads or project managers, in the performance of field work.
- Assist field lead or project managers with data entry, quality assurance, analysis, and summarization to meet protocol and regulatory requirements.

#### Applicants must have:

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in range management, natural resource ecology, biology, botany, or applicable field.
- 1 to 2 years of experience in natural resource field work preferred.
- Preferred experience working in the Northern Great Plains, Rocky Mountains, and Intermountain West, including identification of fauna, flora, ecological assemblages, wetlands, and soils.
- Familiarity with Word, Excel, and Geospatial Information Systems (GIS).
- Ability to travel and work remotely, possibly solo, in inclement weather conditions.
- A positive attitude and ability to work well as part of a team.
- A valid driver's license and clean driving record.
- Have experience driving 4x4 pickup trucks, ATVs, and UTVs
